Investing is about choosing to spend time with those who don't yet know Jesus. Where and with whom does this happen in your life?

What can you do to invest in the relationships that already exist in your life? Think of 1 or 2 specific examples.

Intersecting is about God's story overlapping with your story, your story overlapping with theirs and eventually God's story overlapping with theirs. How can we bring God into the flow of regular conversations? Brainstorm some ideas together.

If time permits look at John 4:1-26 to learn how the Master did this.

There comes the time when we need to invite others to follow Jesus. What thoughts come to mind as you think about doing that?

In Mark 12:30-31 Jesus said we should love God and love people. How do we love God? How do we love people? What is the single most loving thing you think we can do for people?
